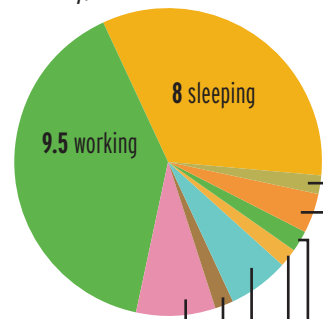


# My so-called life, career

I am limitless in my creativity and imagination. And love brainstorming with myself in the quiet of my car.

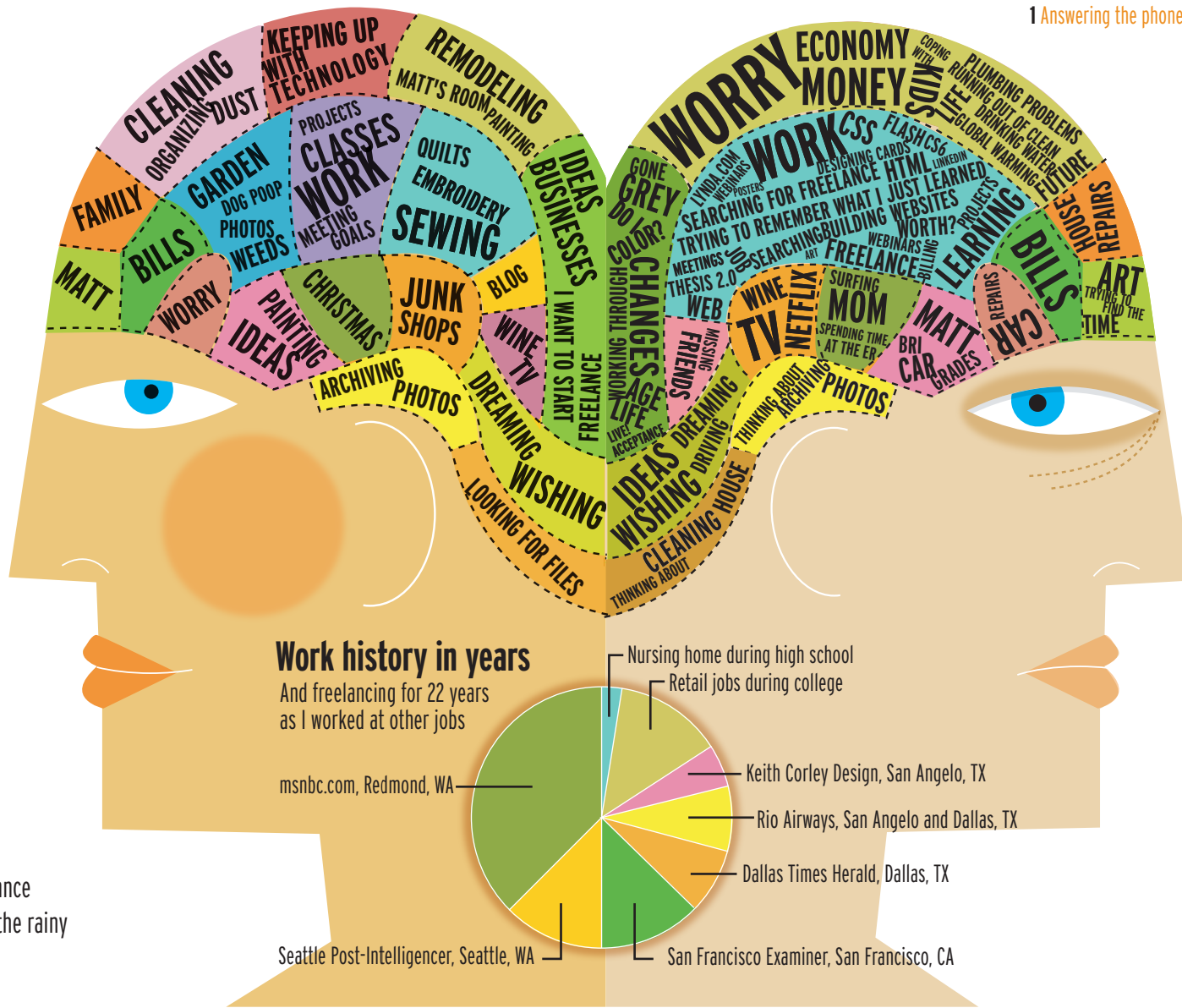
I photograph flowers. Sometimes I write for EdmondsPatch about my garden. I like rings, the bigger the better. And I make big rings out of recycled wood.

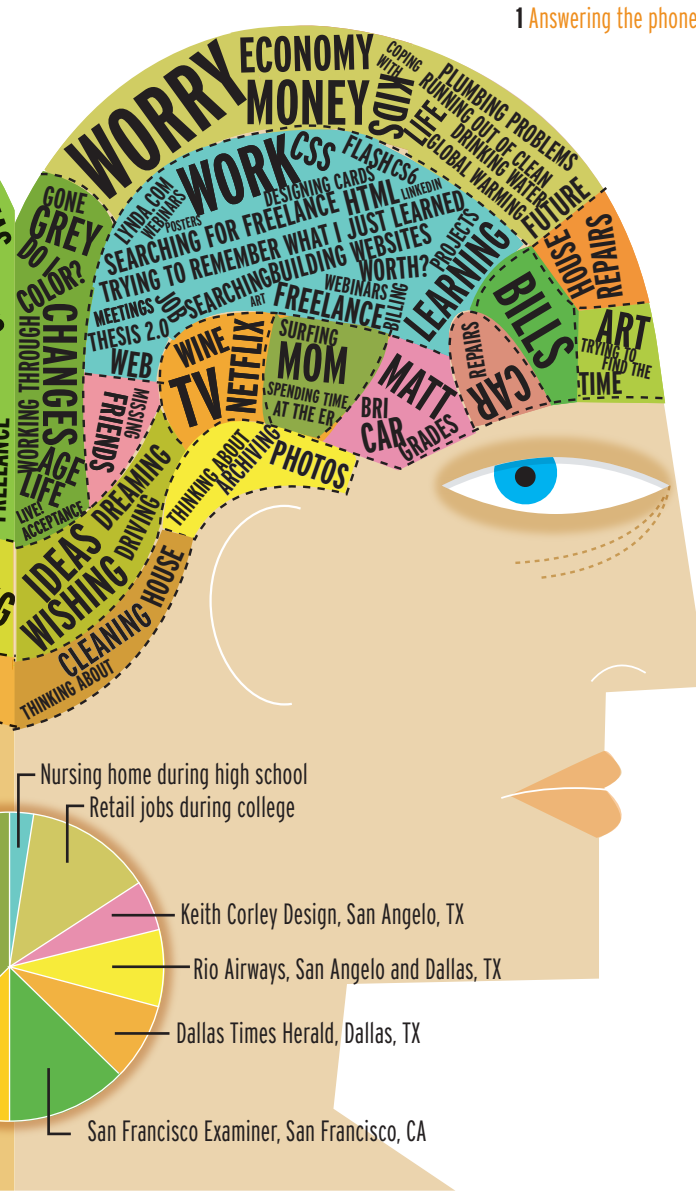
I make stuff fun and I make fun stuff.

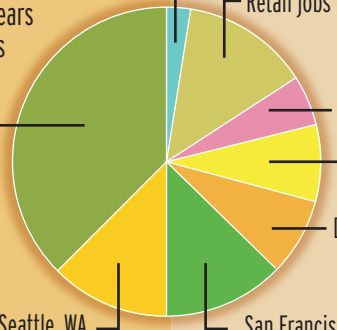

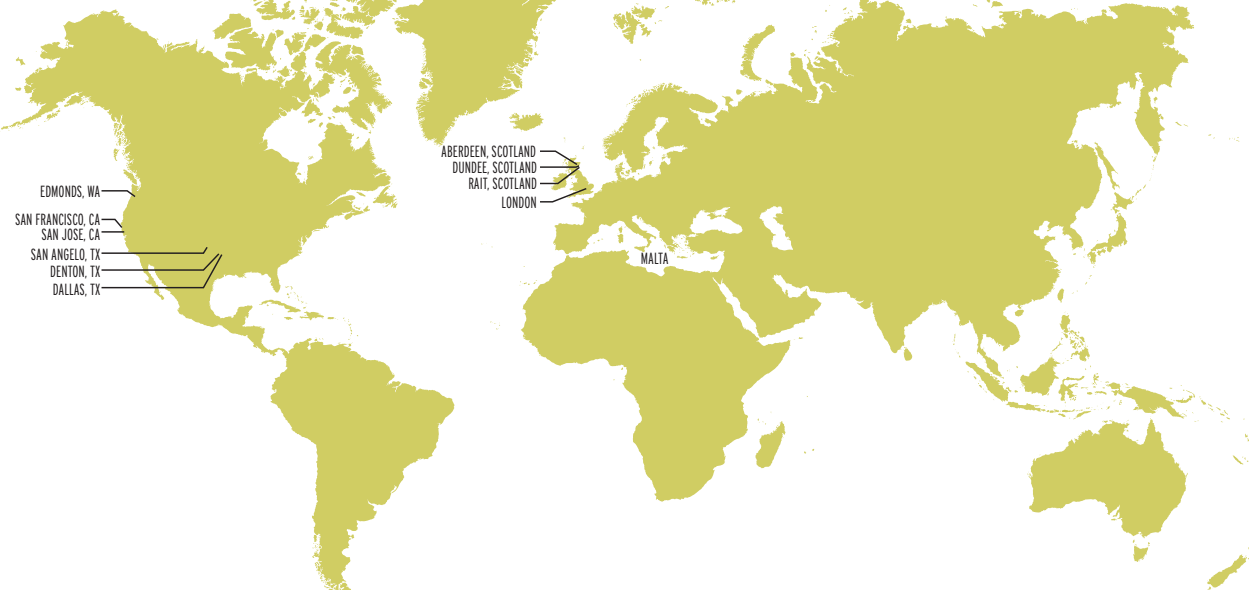

And freelancing for 22 years as I worked at other jobs

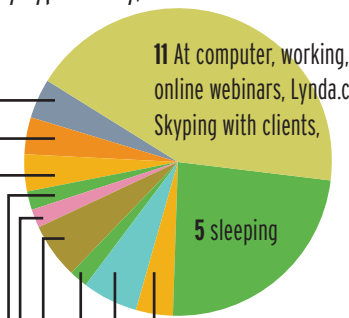


## Where in the world?
